ATTENTION ALL GRADE X STUDENTS

Bring your fully charged laptops and notebooks.

Form a group of 4–5 members prior to the meeting.

Submit your preliminary project theme to your class captain by Thursday afternoon.

Attendance is strictly compulsory. Students who cannot attend due to medical reasons must submit a doctor's certificate to the Student Affairs office before the session begins. Late submissions or unexcused absences will result in a 10% deduction from your overall project grade.

The Project Committee

Answer the following questions according to the text above ! (Level C5 - Evaluating)

1. A student named Budi is sick on Friday morning and cannot attend the briefing. He asks his friend to text Mr. Aris on Saturday to explain his absence without providing a doctor's note. Based on the announcement, is Budi's action appropriate?
 - a. Yes, because informing the teacher through a friend is sufficient.
 - b. Yes, because Mr. Aris is the designated contact person for inquiries.
 - c. No, because doctor's notes must be submitted to Student Affairs before the session starts.
 - d. No, because sick students are not allowed to participate in the End-of-Semester Project.
 - e. Yes, provided he brings the laptop on the following Monday.
2. A group of Grade X students decides to select their project theme during the Friday briefing session. Evaluating the text, is their timeline suitable with the guidelines?
 - a. Suitable, because the briefing is designed to discuss project ideas.
 - b. Suitable, as long as they bring fully charged laptops to the main hall.
